General Information:

- General information about the DBM can be found on its main page.
- Topics regarding your curriculum, i.e. regulations, agreements and helpful tips can be found at the <u>GRACE office</u> and university <u>statutes</u>.

You can switch most University sites to ENG at the top left.

Personal Integrity and Code of Conduct:

- Employees should commit to the Code of Conduct, which aims to avoid abuse and escalation.
- If you witness a problematic situation, share it with colleagues or your PI.
- Furthermore you can contact the <u>DBM personal integrity contacts</u> or the <u>university-wide integrity office</u> Of course, initial contacts are all handled confidentially!

Position as a Postdoc:

- Your PI is responsible in enabling you to achieve academic "maturity" → talk about career plans, your goals and what kind of feedback you would like
- It is recommended (and you have the definite right) to attend conferences and workshops
- Consider filing a <u>Postdoc agreement</u> to coordinate conversations about your career.
- You can find opportunities at the university for professional and self-development e.g.in the "transferable skills" program or the innovation office (launching a start-up enterprise).
- The grants office provides information and help with grants applications.

Participation and Networks:

- Keep an eye out for appointment lectures for future new professors, where you can leave a vote.
- Join the <u>Postdoc Club</u> to get an overview of the department, to advocate for the benefit of the postdocs and exchange your ideas and thoughts directly with the management.
- Science exchange via different associations, e.g. <u>Athena's Journey</u> focuses on the career path of women and the <u>Basel Postdoc Network</u> aims to connect Academia and Industry
- <u>AVUBA</u>, is the university-wide association of PhDs and Postdocs (grouping III) and they do an
 important work in representing us.
- The <u>VPOD</u> is the union and official social partner of the UniBas for grouping III and is heavily involved (together with AVUBA) to represent us in the <u>reform of employment conditions for</u> grouping III.
